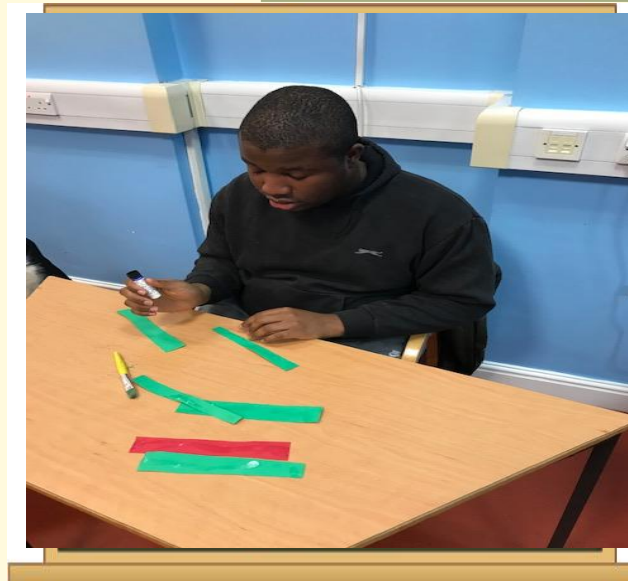


## Our School

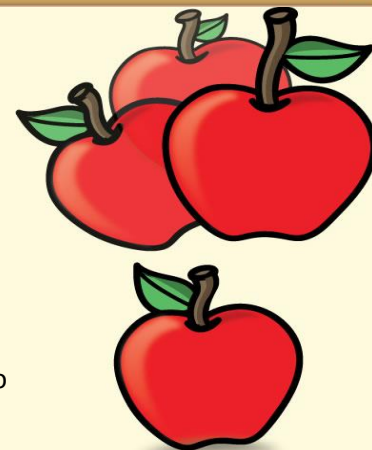
## Educational

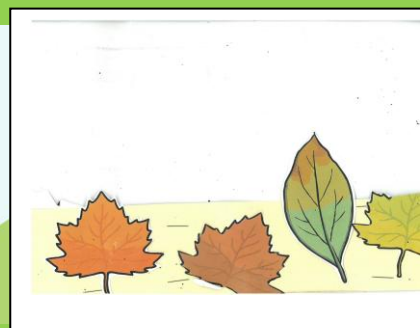
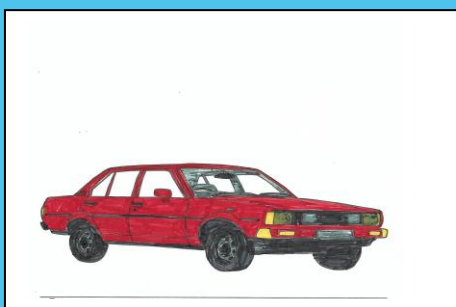
